Library Catalog: Find materials here

Everything in the SESA Library is listed in the catalog, and there are pictures in almost all of the records so you can see what items look like. You can also see if there is a copy of an item in the library or not. If all copies are checked out, I can reserve it for you.

The first thing you will see on the library page (https://sesa.org/library/) is a search box. You can enter terms into the top box and click the search button. You'll be taken to the LibraryWorld catalog, and you'll see a list of results.

To go straight to the library catalog, use this link: http://opac.libraryworld.com/opac/home.php It should log you in automatically, but if it doesn't, the username is sesalibrary, and the password is sesa

You can narrow your search by adding additional words, such as the author's name.

You can search by many fields, including author, title, call number, subject, and more. Click on the drop-down box. A keyword search will always get you the largest number of results.

To request items, you can just copy and paste the information about the item into an email to me (afreitag@sesa.org). I will mail them out to you.
